The hand-over ceremony for 'The Project for the Construction of Classroom Block at Serameng Primary School in Kweneng District' was held at Serameng Primary School on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2017.

This project was for the construction of one classroom block (2 class room: 223 m² floor area) in Metsimotlhabe, Mogoditshane Sub District, approximately half an hour by car from the centre of capital city, Gaborone. US\$70,018 was granted by the Government of Japan to the Mogoditshane/Thamaga Sub District Council, the recipient, for the construction of one classroom block. At Serameng Primary School, part of pupils have not had their own rooms for learning; therefore, they have been taught outside, under trees. With our assistance, the pupils are expected to have higher motivation and academic performance within a secure environment.

Mr. Masahiro Onishi stated that he sincerely hoped the future of the children will be brighter, and they will support the development and prosperity of Botswana.
