1. TICADI (1993), II (1998), III (2003)

- (1) Poverty, civil war, and HIV/AIDS in Africa
- (2) Main agenda: Social development by ODA
- (3) Economic growth since 2000s

2. TICADIV (2008)

- (1) Commitment for Infrastructure development, Rice production, etc
- (2) Shift to Economic development

3. TICADV (2013)

- (1) Main agenda "Aid to Investment" and "Aid for Trade"
- (2) Commitment for Corridor development and ABE Initiative
