20 on the outside, 73 on the inside! She's super cute, but something about her is a little...different. The girl "beyond her years" with the big secret is set to win over Japan.



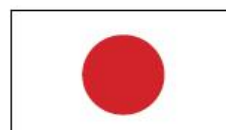
A Living Promise
