Saturday 7th Oct @14h00 (2017, 129 Mins)

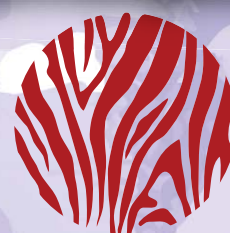
**GENRE: Fantasy, Family**
