## The Embassy Hosted the 'Friends of Japan' Dinner Reception

During the ceremony, Ambassador OHMORI introduced the universities where international students will study and the characteristics of each region, and stated that the Japanese Government supports the Botswana Government through various human resource development programs.

For his part, Mr. Kgopotso Ramoroka, the Deputy Permanent Secretary-Education Support in the Ministry of Education and Skills Development, hailed the Government of Japan for its contribution to Botswana's education sector, through technical support and skills training, which it continues to extend to Batswana. He encouraged the scholarship recipients to utilize this as an opportunity to bring expertise from Japan, and also to share their skills and sell their culture to the international community, while in Japan.
