## The first Japan-Botswana Online Exchange at Ben Thema Primary School

For the first time in the school's history, a Japan-Botswana online exchange was held on the 17<sup>th</sup> October 2023 at Ben Thema Primary School in Gaborone. This online exchange was one of the events held to celebrate the 10th anniversary of the Tsuzuki-Botswana Exchange of Children's Paintings Exhibition.

The Standard 3 students of Ben Thema Primary School and the Grade 3 students of Chigasaki Primary School in Yokohama, Japan enjoyed the online exchange programme. Students from both schools performed songs, played the recorder and held traditional performances, which was followed by a question-and-answer session. More than 100 children from each school participated in the exchange together with their principals and homeroom teachers, providing a great opportunity to learn about their respective cultures.

From Japanese side, Tsuzuki Ward Office of Yokohama City, Tsuzuki Multicultural & Youth Plaza (Community Centre) and the Embassy of Botswana in Japan also participated in the event. From Batswana side, Embassy of Japan in Botswana, JICA Botswana and JOCV Volunteers also joined the online exchange. Mr. Daniel Kgasa, Counsellor and Deputy Head of Mission, remarked that it was significant opportunity for both school's students. His Excellency Mr. OHMORI Setsuo, Ambassador of Japan to Botswana shared a few words in English and Japanese for the students of Ben Thema and Chigasaki Primary School. Ambassador told the students, "This year marks the 10th anniversary of the yearly children's painting exhibition and I strongly hope that the cultural exchange between the two schools through the painting exhibition will continue".

In early November, the 10th anniversary of the Tsuzuki-Botswana Children's Exchange Painting Exhibition will be held at Ben Thema Primary School. There will be an exhibition of more than 200 drawings from both Japan and Botswana, where students will be able to enjoy the contrast between the two cultures. The purpose of the event is to nurture wider cultural collaboration between Japan and Botswana through the children's paintings.
